INTRODUCTION:

We've just finished our sermon series about the basics in Christian living, and we have learned a lot about what is expected from a person once he or she commits to follow and walk with Jesus. We came to a conclusion that the Five Basic Purposes of the Church or the Body of Christ; Fellowship, Worship, Discipleship, Ministry and Evangelism, are all essentials and non-negotiable in our walk with Christ.

Many Christians fall into complacency and forget what it means to be a Christian. As a result, many believers lower their standards and expectations as to how to live as a follower of Christ. When standards and expectations are lowered, commitment also drops, and that will lead to living irresponsibly and eventually unfruitfulness. We don't want that! God certainly doesn't want that also!

Our name, "Christian" should reflect in the way we live our lives. We should not devalue the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross and the grace of God by not fully committing to live a life that honors Him. As God says in Revelations 3:11-12, He will spit out believers who won't give their 100% to Him.

Still another said, "I will follow you, Lord; but first let me go back and say goodbye to my family." Jesus replied, "No one who puts a hand to the plow and looks back is fit for service in the kingdom of God.
